ABOUT US



The San Antonio Missions was founded as a charter member of the Texas League in 1888. Since the inaugural season a number of franchises were hosted by San Antonio. Mostly known as the Missions, the team also went by the names, "Missionaries", "Gentlemen", and the "Bronchos". A number of Hall of Famers started with the Missions including: Ron Santo, Billy Williams, Joe Morgan, and Jerry Grote. The Double A affiliate for the San Diego Padres since 2007, the Missions are committed to fostering relationships with community non-profit partners to help raise awareness and funds.



Since 2011, Texas Kidney Foundation (TKF) has been dedicated to the early detection of Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD), a silent but deadly disease estimated to affect one in three people. TKF takes a proactive approach by offering free early detection kidney screenings and providing support and educational resources to patients, families, caregivers and medical professionals affected by CKD. The untold history of San Antonio's African American descendants is rich and intricately tied to the stories of Spaniards, Mexicans, Germans and Canary Island populations who helped build this great city. The San Antonio African American Community Archive and Museum (SAAACAM) is working in a grassroots effort to uncover the legacy that reaches back to the early days of the Spanish colonists and Texas Republic. SAAACAM is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization founded in 2017, to collect, maintain, disseminate, and interpret authentic African American artifacts related to San Antonio history in a community-based digital archive.
